

~~PROPOSED~~ **DEFAULT JUDGMENT
AND PERMANENT INJUNCTION**

1 Based upon Plaintiffs' Application for Default Judgment By The Court, and good cause
2 appearing therefore, it is hereby Ordered and Adjudged that:

3 1. Plaintiffs seek the minimum statutory damages of \$750 per infringed work, as
4 authorized under the Copyright Act (17 U.S.C. § 504(c)(1)), for each of the seven (7) sound
5 recordings listed in Exhibit A to Plaintiffs' Complaint. Accordingly, having adjudged to be in
6 default, Defendant Shauna Brown ("Defendant") shall pay damages to Plaintiffs for infringement of
7 Plaintiffs' copyrights in the sound recordings listed in Exhibit A to the Complaint, in the total
8 principal sum of Five Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$5,250.00).

9 2. Defendant shall further pay Plaintiffs' costs of suit herein in the amount of Two
10 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

11 3. Defendant shall be and hereby is enjoined from directly or indirectly infringing
12 Plaintiffs' rights under federal or state law in the following copyrighted sound recordings:

- 13 • "Killing in the Name," on album "Rage Against the Machine," by artist "Rage
14 Against the Machine" (SR# 152-061);
- 15 • "Hate Me Now," on album "I Am," by artist "Nas" (SR# 175-149);
- 16 • "Dragula," on album "Hellbilly Deluxe," by artist "Rob Zombie" (SR# 257-901);
- 17 • "It's a Sin," on album "Actually," by artist "Pet Shop Boys" (SR# 93-012);
- 18 • "Hunter," on album "No Angel," by artist "Dido" (SR# 289-904);
- 19 • "Symphony of Destruction," on album "Countdown to Extinction," by artist
20 "Megadeth" (SR# 175-385);
- 21 • "Breaking the Girl," on album "Blood Sugar Sex Magik," by artist "Red Hot Chili
22 Peppers" (SR# 135-276);

23 and in any other sound recording, whether now in ^{existence} ~~experience~~ or later created, that is owned or
24 controlled by the Plaintiffs (or any parent, subsidiary, or affiliate record label of Plaintiffs)
25 ("Plaintiffs' Recordings"), including without limitation by using the Internet or any online media
26 distribution system to reproduce (i.e., download) any of Plaintiffs' Recordings, to distribute (i.e.,
27 upload) and of Plaintiffs' Recordings, or to make any of Plaintiffs' Recordings available for
28 distribution to the public, except pursuant to a lawful license or with the express authority of

1 Plaintiffs. Defendant shall also destroy all copies of Plaintiffs' Recordings that defendant has
2 downloaded onto any computer hard drive or server without Plaintiffs' authorization and shall
3 destroy all copies of those downloaded recordings transferred onto any physical medium or device in
4 Defendant's possession, custody, or control.
