David Lamond with respect to confidential portions of his
deposition testimony and an accompanying exhibit, the redactions
proposed by plaintiffs Cal IV Entertainment, LLC, Stage Three
Music (U.S.), Inc., The Rogers & Hammerstein Organization with
respect to the confidential portions of exhibits filed in
support of defendants' motion for summary judgment, and the

redactions proposed by the plaintiffs in the Viacom action and plaintiffs Music Force Media Group LLC, The Music Force LLC, Sin-Drome Records, Ltd. with respect to confidential personal information contained in exhibits filed in support of defendants' motion for summary judgment - together with the reasons given for continued confidential treatment of the designated material, I have determined that the protection of the value of this private, proprietary and commercially sensitive information to its owners clearly outweighs any countervailing public interest in its disclosure to the general public and to competitors, and justifies its redaction, together with personally identifiable matter such as addresses, telephone and account numbers, family and personal affairs and similar information, from material publicly filed and disclosed.
