Dear Heather,

here are a load more Prince video files. This list below isn't even 1/8th of the illegal Prince videos on your site. I suggest YouTube either start policing itself or else face legal ramifications. Otherwise, you can pay our lawyers' office \$200-\$400 an hour to police it for you.

You cannot expect copyright holders to police your website for you on their time while YouTube gets away with breaking the law repeatedly. That would be akin to a mall allowing drug dealing and prostitution on its property and only telling those people to leave when someone complained about it, then letting the same dealers and prostitutes back in the next day.

Also, it would help your cause greatly if you sent YouTube participants takedown notices telling them that they could be liable for more than \$100,000 per copyright infringement, since in essence, these multitudes of people are amounting to your breaking the law millions of times per day. In many cases, the same user will post dozens of infringing files. Hosting these files is illegal/period

I went through and did confirm that most of the titles listed here (if not all) are unique enough in that there are no other videos out there currently with these exact titles. This is sufficient specificity in your case. In reviewing your email, however, I do need one more thing from you in order to move forward. I need a statement from you that satisfies this point in the DMCA:

- (vi) A statement that the information in the notification is accurate, and under penalty of perjury, that the complaining party is authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right that is allegedly infringed.

Once I have this I will remove the videos in question.

Moving forward, please follow these steps when requesting the removal of videos for copyright infringement. This is not our user policy, this is what is required by the DMCA.

thank you for responding. I sent you the exact titles of each one, pasted directly from Youtube with the wording each user used. In the event you find more than one with the same title, that means they both need to come down. It's pretty clear who Prince is so I'm sure you company will have no trouble determining what's what.

I can try sending you the direct links from the extensive list I emailed to myself on AOL if you wish. As it took me several hours to compile the list, I do not want to go back through and do this again as it is youtube.com which should be policing itself, not the copyright holders. This is why companies such as Napster.com have been shut down.

Additionally, you should be aware that there are loads of infringements all over your site (not just Prince issues). I would imagine the RIAA or other entities will be trying to shut youtube.com down just as they did to the original Napster/Gnutella, etc. A user-based filesharing website is no different than user-based filesharing software and must comply to the same laws. Expecting the enduser to comply with your user agreement is really wishful thinking when it comes to the Internet.
