Forwarding the spec + some clarification on it in the email below.

I'm done with everything except (3) and (4). We aren't doing the multiple email addresses per account this push. Regarding (3) and (4), I've done a lot of it already.

The big pieces that remain unfinished:

1) i created a UserAbuse table and it's being used to track each time the user gets a video dinged (there are two types of dings, one is just rejecting the video but doesn't increment the three strikes rule, the other one does increment the three strikes rule). the thing is, this part hasn't been hooked up yet to actually closing the =account.

2) there are a few functions in user.py (check against revision 4301:4302 on user.py).

I think there are still a couple days of work left on this.

I'm checking this stuff in now, let me know if you have problems, Pan.
