Hi Luis,

Thanks for your message.

Please note that a different video, even with a similar title, will not be blocked until we receive a separate DMCA request for that specific video.

When I'm doing a search on YT on "Ovos em Ipanema parte 2", three videos do show up in the search results. One of them is still active and can be played, and two of them are blocked. In order for the active video to be blocked, we need to receive a separate DMCA request from the content owner.

I tried to play the video "Ovos em Ipanema parte 2" :

=> Could you confirm that you are still able the play the video on this specific URL? If so, would you be able to send us a screen shot?
