
Dear Judge Stanton:

The Court's Order denying our motion to strike the Page deposition takes the form of a memo endorsement on the first page of our April 30, 2010 Motion To Strike Material From Viacom's Summary Judgment Submissions And Putative Class Plaintiffs' Rule 56.1 Statement. That motion (which was filed Friday) addresses not only the Page deposition but other matters, as well, none of which was discussed at the conference and as to none of which the plaintiffs have yet responded. Given that, and the specific language of the endorsement, we assume that the Court's Order pertains only to the Page deposition, and that the other issues are still pending, but if we are mistaken about that, we respectfully ask that the Court so inform the parties.
