## RONALD L. ELLIS, United States Magistrate Judge:

Following submissions by the Parties and a telephonic conference with the Court on June 15, 2009.

The Court finds that Defendant OST Trucks & Cranes ("OST") has failed to demonstrate reasonable diligence for the failure to produce its Supplemental Production in advance of the

depositions of its witnesses. Moreover, as expert reports have now been exchanged, it would be St. Paul Travelers Insurance Company Ltd. v. M/V Madame Butterfly et al prejudicial and inefficient to allow additional fact discovery.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that OST SHALL BE PRECLUDED from relying on any documents contained in its Supplemental Production.
