DECLARATION OF LAURA SCILEPPI CONCERNING
THE NOTICE TO BANK OF AMERICA
OF THE APRIL 27, 2009 ORDER

LAURA SCILEPPI hereby declares pursuant to 28
U.S.C. § 1746 that the following is true and correct:

1. I am a member of the bar of this Court and
an associate at Dunnegan LLC, attorneys for plaintiff in
this action.

2. On April 27, 2007, Mr. Dunnegan and I
visited the branch of Bank of America located at 350 Fifth
Avenue, New York, New York for the purpose of serving the
April 27, 2007 order on Bank of America.

3. Upon arriving at the bank, we asked a
receptionist to speak with someone on whom we could serve
some legal documents.

4. After a brief delay, the receptionist introduced us to Mr. Joe Hah. We explained to Mr. Hah that we needed to serve an order that would freeze an account in California, and asked if he could help us do that. He said that he could. We then provided him with a copy of the April 27, 2007 order and gave him the number of the account of defendant that we wanted to make sure was frozen. We told him that it was important that the account be frozen immediately.

5. While we sat in his office, Mr. Hah went to fax a copy of the order to the department of the Bank that was responsible for freezing accounts. When he returned to his office, he told us that the telecopy had been sent to the appropriate department of the Bank responsible for freezing accounts and the account would be frozen before the end of the day.

6. We then asked Mr. Hah to sign a receipt of the order, which he did.
