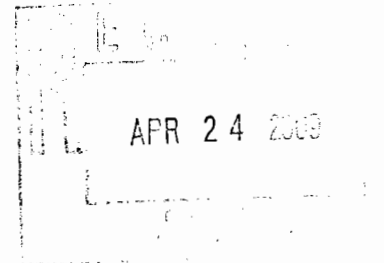

Dear Judge Marrero:

We represent defendants Fairfield Greenwich Limited, Fairfield Greenwich (Bermuda) Ltd., and Fairfield Greenwich Advisors LLC in *Bhatia et al. v. Standard Chartered International (USA) Ltd, et al.*, 09 CV 2410 (“*Bhatia*”), an action involving the Madoff fraud that on April 21, 2009 was transferred from Judge Swain to this Court. A copy of the Notice of Reassignment is attached for the Court’s convenience.

We write in accordance with the Court’s January 30, 2009 Consolidation Order and Order for Appointment of Interim Co-Lead Counsel (the “Consolidation Order”) in *Anwar et al. v. Fairfield Greenwich Limited, et al.*, Docket No. 09 CV 0118 (“*Anwar*” or the “Consolidated Action”), a consolidated action pending in this Court similarly involving the Madoff fraud. Paragraphs 5 and 6 of the Consolidation Order require counsel in *Anwar* to “cooperate in calling to the attention of the Clerk any newly filed or transferred case” that “relates to the same subject matter” as the consolidated *Anwar* action. See Consolidation Order ¶¶ 5-6.

We also write to respectfully request consolidation of *Bhatia* into *Anwar*. We believe that consolidation is appropriate pursuant to both the Consolidation Order and the Court’s March 11, 2009 Civil Case Management Plan and Scheduling Order in *Anwar* (the “CMO”). Pursuant to the Consolidation Order, “the Court finds that it would be appropriate to consolidate with the Anwar Consolidated Action any additional related actions filed in or transferred to this Court after the date of this Order.” See Consolidation Order at 2. Paragraph 1 of the CMO further provides that “[a]ll subsequently filed or transferred cases...arising from or relating to the facts and claims alleged in the Consolidated Action, including...any alleged losses in connection with investments made through or with Bernard Madoff...shall be consolidated, for all purposes, with the Consolidated Action.” See CMO ¶ 1.

Both *Anwar* and *Bhatia* concern such losses from investments made with Madoff. Moreover, there is substantial overlap between the claims and parties in *Bhatia* and *Anwar*, and the *Bhatia* plaintiffs are included as members of the putative class pled in *Anwar*. Accordingly, under the plain terms of the Court's prior orders, it seems clear that consolidation of *Bhatia* into *Anwar* is called for.


We appreciate the Court's attention to this matter.
