Petitioners have moved, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(f), for leave to appeal the district court's order granting Respondents' motion for class certification. Petitioners also have moved for leave to file replies in support of their petitions. More recently, however, the Petitioners in the case docketed under 15-806 have moved for their Rule 23(f) petition to be held in abeyance and for that motion to be sealed.

Upon due consideration, it is hereby ORDERED that the motions to file replies are GRANTED, the motion to hold in abeyance the Rule 23(f) petition docketed under 15-806 is GRANTED, and the motion to seal the preceding motion is GRANTED. The Rule 23(f) petition docketed under 15-792 is DENIED because an immediate appeal is unwarranted. *See Sumitomo Copper Litig. v. Credit Lyonnais Rouse, Ltd.*, 262 F.3d 134, 139-40 (2d Cir. 2001).
