AMENDED ORDER

VICTOR MARRERO, United States District Judge.

By Order dated May 5, 2009 ("May 5 Order"), the Court directed the Clerk of Court to consolidate the two cases captioned above for all purposes. Plaintiff Nadav Zohar ("Zohar") objects to the consolidation insofar as it includes

claims plaintiffs asserted in case number 09 Civ. 4031 against various Pricewaterhouse Coopers entities. Having considered Zohar's objections, the Court amends the May 5 Order as set forth below. Accordingly, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that the Clerk of Court is directed to consolidate the two cases captioned above for all pretrial purposes; and it is further

**ORDERED** that all filings in connection with the consolidated action be docketed against the remaining lower number case, 09 Civ. 0118; and it is further

**ORDERED** that any filing of papers or correspondence with the Court that relates solely to Nadav Zohar, et al. v. Fairfield Greenwich Group, et al. ("Zohar"), Case No. 09 Civ. 4031, shall so indicate in the face of such submission by reference to the case as 09 Civ. 0118 (Zohar); and it is further

**ORDERED** that the parties in the consolidated cases are directed to coordinate all pretrial proceedings, which shall be conducted under the supervision of Magistrate Judge Theodore Katz; and it is further

**ORDERED** that upon completion of pretrial proceedings, in the event any claims in Zohar remain to be tried, the Court in conjunction with the parties will consider severing, as appropriate, any claims in the Zohar matter for which separate trial would be warranted.
