STIPULATION AND ORDER

**WHEREAS**, Fairfield Sentry Limited ("Fairfield Sentry") initiated the action captioned *Fairfield Sentry Limited v. Fairfield Greenwich Group, et al.* in the Supreme Court of the State of New York on or about May 29, 2009 (the "Action");

**WHEREAS**, Defendant Fairfield Greenwich Advisors, LLC ("Fairfield Greenwich") removed the Action on or about June 19, 2009 to the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York;

**WHEREAS** the Action was consolidated by order dated June 25, 2009 with the above-captioned *Anwar* action for all purposes;

**WHEREAS**, on July 10, 2009, Fairfield Sentry moved to remand the Action and to vacate the consolidation order (the "Motion to Remand");

**WHEREAS**, on July 27, 2009, Fairfield Greenwich served and filed papers in opposition

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of the Motion to Remand;


**WHEREAS**, on August 18, 2009, the date for Fairfield Sentry to serve and file reply papers in further support of the Motion to Remand was extended from August 21, 2009 to September 25, 2009;

**WHEREAS**, on September 21, 2009, Kenneth M. Kryz and Christopher D. Stride, Virgin Islands court-appointed liquidators of and for Fairfield Sentry Limited requested a pre-motion conference before the Honorable Victor Marrero in anticipation of moving for an order pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 25(c) substituting Fairfield Sentry Limited (in Liquidation), by its Liquidators for plaintiff Fairfield Sentry Limited (the "Substitution Motion"), which request is *sub judice*;

**WHEREAS**, Fairfield Sentry seeks an extension of the date to serve and file reply papers in further support of the Motion to Remand in light of the anticipated Substitution Motion, and to allow time for the District Court's consideration and ruling on the Substitution Motion, and Fairfield Greenwich does not object to such an extension;




