### A BILL

To amend title 35, United States Code, to prohibit the patenting of human genetic material.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Genomic Research and
- 5 Accessibility Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON PATENT OF HUMAN GENETIC MA-
- 7 TERIAL.
- 8 (a) In General.—Chapter 10 of title 35, United
- 9 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 10 lowing new section:

#### 1 "§ 106. Prohibition on patent of human genetic mate-

- 3 "Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no pat-
- 4 ent may be obtained for a nucleotide sequence, or its func-
- 5 tions or correlations, or the naturally occurring products
- 6 it specifies.".
- 7 (b) Table of Contents.—The table of sections of
- 8 chapter 10 of title 35, United States Code, is amended
- 9 by adding at the end the following:
  - "106. Prohibition on patent of human genetic material.".
- 10 (c) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub-
- 11 section (a) shall not apply to a patent issued before the
- 12 date of the enactment of this Act.

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
