Dear Judge Daniels:

We represent defendant Interscope Geffen A&M Records, Inc., a division of UMG Recordings, Inc. ("Interscope"), in the above-referenced action (the "Action") and write with the consent of Plaintiffs' counsel to respectfully request an adjournment of the initial conference which is scheduled to take place on April 13, 2010 at 9:45 a.m. As the Court is aware, Interscope has appeared in the Action and its fully-briefed motion to dismiss the Complaint is sub judice. We were recently retained to represent the individual members of the band and their responses to the Complaint are not due until May 3, 2010. We are currently investigating whether we can also represent the remaining defendant in the Action.
