- 4. Dispositive motions on liability, if any, to be served no later than September 23, 2011.
- 5. All damages discovery shall be deferred until the determination of summary judgment on liability. In the event that Plaintiffs prevail on liability, such discovery shall occur following the determination of summary judgment and before trial.
