

ORDER



On November 5, 2010, the remaining parties in this case jointly applied for a delay of depositions until the conclusion of the pending related criminal trial before Judge Holwell. Counsel for defendant Zvi Goffer further suggested a delay of depositions until the conclusion of the pending related criminal trial before Judge Sullivan.

The Court is reluctant to grant such an open-ended and lengthy postponement. However, in light of the Second Circuit's decision in Sec. and Exch. Comm'n v. Rajaratnam, No. 10-462-cv, 2010 U.S. App. LEXIS 20179 (2d. Cir. Sept. 29, 2010), the Court deems it appropriate to postpone all depositions at least until Judge Holwell decides the wiretap suppression motion currently pending before him. Accordingly, all deposition discovery in the case is hereby adjourned until one week after that suppression motion is decided (without prejudice to further adjournments thereafter, depending on the circumstances).

Meanwhile, however, document discovery shall proceed as scheduled in accordance with the Court's case management plan.
