On November 24, 2010, the Honorable Richard J. Holwell denied the motions of defendants Raj Rajaratnam and Danielle Chiesi to suppress wiretap evidence in the related criminal matter of <u>United</u> <u>States v. Rajaratnam</u>, 09 Cr. 1184. Accordingly, in a telephone conference with the Court on December 2, 2010, the Securities and Exchange Commission indicated its intent to renew its motion to obtain from defendants the wiretap evidence for use in the instant civil case. The Court therefore sets the following motion schedule:

(1) Plaintiff's renewed motion must be filed by December 17,2010;

(2) Defendants' opposition papers must be filed by January 5,2011;

(3) Plaintiff's reply papers must be filed by January 12, 2011;and

(4) Oral argument on the motion will be held on January 20, 2011 at 5:00 p.m. Doc. 175

Meanwhile, deposition discovery in the case is stayed until the oral argument on January 20, 2011, at which point the Court will consider a schedule for deposition discovery. Similarly, the trial currently set to begin on February 14, 2011 is hereby adjourned, and the rescheduling of the trial will be considered at the time of the January 20, 2011 oral argument.
