ORDER

On October 27, 2010, the Court entered a Consent Order and Judgment as to Defendant Roomy Khan. At that time, counsel for the Commission and counsel for Khan asked that the Court defer a determination of civil penalties so that any such determination could permit an assessment of Khan's cooperation. Accordingly, the Consent Order provided that the Court would determine no later than October 27, 2011, whether it is appropriate to order a civil penalty against Khan and, if so, the amount of the penalty. Counsel for the Commission and counsel for Khan have jointly requested an adjournment of the control date set previously by the Court and have supported that request with good cause. Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the date by which the Court shall determine whether it is appropriate to order a civil penalty against Khan and, if so, the amount of the penalty, is hereby adjourned to December 31, 2011.
