


STIPULATION AND ORDER

On November 5, 2010, the Court entered a Consent Order and Judgment as to Defendant Rajiv Goel. At that time, counsel for the Commission and counsel for Goel asked that the Court defer a determination of civil penalties so that any such determination could permit an assessment of Goel's cooperation. Counsel for the Commission and counsel for Goel have jointly requested and stipulated to an adjournment of the date set previously by the Court and have supported that request with good cause. Further, both parties recognize that no further adjournments shall be granted. Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the date by which the Court shall determine whether it is appropriate to order a civil penalty against Goel and, if so, the amount of the penalty, is hereby adjourned to April 27, 2012.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, otherwise, the Consent Order and Judgment as to Defendant Rajiv Goel shall remain in full force and effect.


