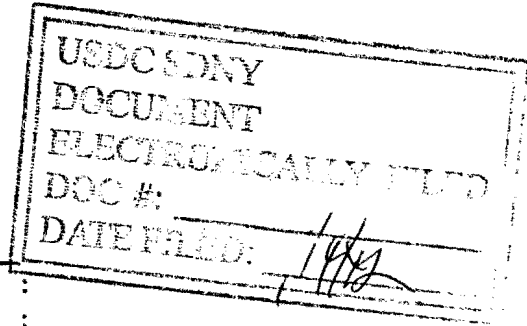



STIPULATION AND ORDER

On June 8, 2011, the Court entered a Consent Order and Judgment as to Defendant Gautham Shankar. At that time, counsel for the Commission and counsel for Shankar asked that the Court defer a determination of civil penalties so that any such determination could permit an assessment of Shankar's cooperation. Counsel for the Commission and counsel for Shankar have jointly requested and stipulated to an adjournment of the date set previously by the Court and have supported that request with good cause. Further, both parties recognize that no further adjournments shall be granted. Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the date by which the Court shall determine whether it is appropriate to order a civil penalty against Shankar and, if so, the amount of the penalty, is hereby adjourned to April 27, 2012.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, otherwise, the Consent Order and Judgment as to Defendant Gautham Shankar shall remain in full force and effect.
