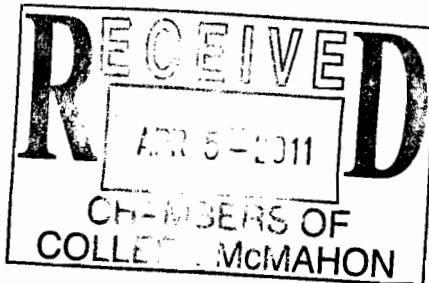

Dear Judge McMahon:

Pursuant to paragraph 2(D) of this Court's Individual Practices, defendants Lisa Kirby, Neal Kirby, Susan Kirby and Barbara Kirby (the "Kirbys") write to request in connection with their motion for summary judgment a five page extension of the page limit applicable to their reply brief, to be filed on Friday, April 8, 2011. Due to the voluminous exhibits filed by plaintiffs and plaintiffs' characterization of the evidentiary record in their opposition, the Kirbys request this five page extension to more reasonably address the entirety of plaintiffs' arguments.
