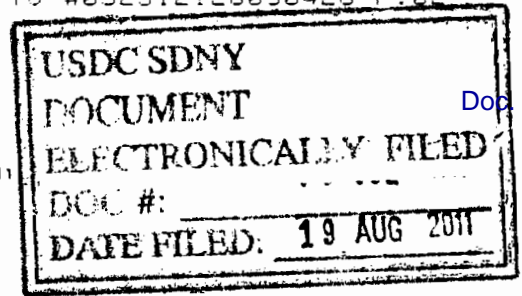

This firm represents the Defendant, Kelley Drye & Warren LLP. The joint submission Your Honor has Ordered the parties to file in connection with documents which were filed under seal in connection with the EEOC's motion for partial summary judgment is due today.
