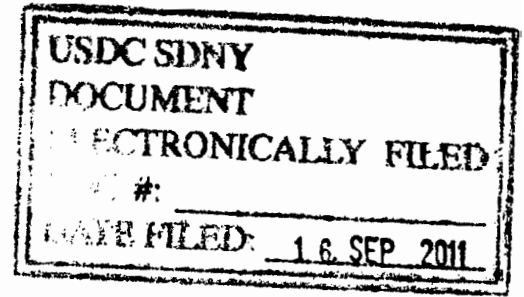


ORDER

On July 29, 2011, Plaintiff Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (the "EEOC") filed objections to Magistrate Judge Michael H. Dolinger's July 15, 2011, order (1) denying without prejudice the EEOC's request to compel Defendant to produce certain compensation information and (2) denying without prejudice the EEOC's request to compel Defendant to provide a breakdown of the designation of client revenues for certain attorneys in a specified form.

Having reviewed the EEOC's objections and the motion papers in connection therewith, the Court concludes that nothing in Judge Dolinger's order is "clearly erroneous or . . . contrary to law." See Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(a). The EEOC's request that this Court reverse the July 15, 2011, order is, therefore, denied.
