"Likelihood to result in serious harm" means: - a substantial risk of physical harts to the person as manifested by threats of or attempts at suicide or serious bodily harts or other conduct demonstrating that the pecson is dangerous to hemself or herself ("other conduct" shall include the person's relusar or inability to meet his or her essential need for food, sheller, cirching, or health care, provided that such refusal or institut is likely to result in sensus harm if there is not immediate hospitalization), or —a substantial risk of physical harm to other persons as manifested by homicidal or other violent behavior by which others are placed in reasonable hear of senous physical herm. 3. A staff physician of the admitting hospital most examine the paraon and find that the person meets the standard for admission under this Section. The physician then completes this Form, OMH 474, Emergency Admissions. B A person who is alleged or appears to be mentally all may be taken into Custody, transported, or removed to a hospital approved to accept emergency admissions, according to the following sections of the Mental Hygiene Law:
—Section 9.41 - Powers of Certain Peace Officers and Police Officers, Form OMH 474A/476A, I -- Section 943 - Powers of Courts - Form OMH 455, Civil Order for Removal to Hospital - Section 9.45 - Powers of Directors of Community Services, Form OMH 474A476A, II -- Section 8.55 - Powers of Qualified Psychiatrists, Form OMH 474A476A, Ill -- Section 9.57 - Powers of Emergency Room Physicians, Form OMH 474A478A, IV C. On admission, the person will be given a written notice of status and rights as a patient admitted according to WHt. Section 9.39. Based upon an examination by a staff physician, you have been admitted as an emergency-status patient to this hospital for persons with mental lilness for immediate observation, care and treatment. Within 48 hours of the time of your admission, you will be examined by another physician, who is a member of the psychiatric staff of this hospital. If he or she confirms the first physician's findings, you may then be kept in the hospital for a period of up to 15 days from the date of your arrival. During this 15 day period you may be released, converted to involuntary status, or asked to remain as a voluntary or informal patient.

You, and anyone acting on your behalf, should feel free to ask hospital staff about your condition, your status and rights under the Mental Hygiene Law, and the rules and regulations of this hospital.

If you, or those acting on your behalf, believe that you do not need immediate observation, care and treatment, you or they may make a written request for a court hearing. Copies of such a request will be forwarded by the hospital director to the appropriate court and the Mental Hygiene Legal Service.

## MENTAL HYGIENE LEGAL SERVICE

The Mental Hygiene Legal Service, a court agency independent of this hospital, can provide you and your family with protective legal services, advice and assistance, including representation, with regard to your hospitalization. You are entitled to be informed of your rights regarding hospitalization and treatment, and have a right to a court hearing, to be represented by a lawyer, and to seek independent medical opinion.

You, or someone acting on your behalf, may see or communicate with a representative of the Mental Hygiene Legal Service by telephoning or writing directly to the office of the Service or by requesting hospital staff to make such arrangements for you.
