Dear Judge Sweet:

As one of plaintiff's counsel, I write to clarify our position on the scheduling for oral argument and for the opposition to the plaintiff's April 11, 2016 letter motion to strike the City Defendants' "expert" report. As we informed counsel for the City Defendants, we have no objection to adjourning the oral argument date on the pending fee motions to May 4th, which is a day that all counsel have agreed upon.
