## DECLARATION OF STEPHEN GRAHAM IN OPPOSITION TO MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

- I, Stephen Graham, hereby declare as follows:
- 1. I am employed by ivi, Inc. and am familiar with its operations. I am over eighteen years of age and make this declaration based on personal knowledge.

2. I participated in an investigation to determine whether the FCC regulated the

transmission of television content over the Internet. Although ivi was confident that the FCC did

not regulate the Internet, I nonetheless contacted the FCC to confirm our understanding.

3. On September 16, 2010, I called FCC representative Ronald Parver. I asked

Mr. Parver whether the FCC governed the Internet at all. With respect to this initial question, I

pointed to the FCC's website at www.fcc.gov/cgb/internet.html, a true and correct copy of which

is attached to this declaration as Exhibit 2, with the relevant portions highlighted in yellow.

Because the FCC website page referred to above literally states that the FCC does not regulate

the Internet, I asked Mr. Parver whether that was still accurate. Mr. Parver responded that it was,

and that the FCC does not regulate the Internet.

4. I followed up my phone conversation with a confirming email seeking additional

confirmation. A true and correct copy of my email exchange is attached as Exhibit 3. In my

email, I asked whether the FCC more specifically governed the use of the Internet to broadcast

television signals, including a cable system using the Internet to retransmit content originally

broadcast over the air. Again, Mr. Parver responded that the FCC did not govern either situation,

and that no FCC involvement was required for using the Internet to transmit video content.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America that the

foregoing is true and correct.
