## RICHARD J. SULLIVAN, District Judge:

The Court is in receipt of the parties' stipulation dated March 25, 2011, requesting an extension of Defendant's time to answer or file a motion for reconsideration to April 8, 2011. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Defendant's time to answer the Complaint is extended to April 8, 2011. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT, if Defendant wishes to file a motion for reconsideration, it shall submit a pre-motion letter as described in Rule 2.A of my Individual Practices by April 8, 2011, and Plaintiff shall submit a responsive letter within three business days. Though pre-motion letters are generally not required for motions of reconsideration under my Individual Practices, the Court believes such letters would be helpful in this case. If Defendant submits a pre-motion letter, Defendant's time to answer the Complaint shall be extended until 14 days after the Court rules on the motion for reconsideration.

The deadlines set by the Court's March 22, 2011 Order remain in effect. If Defendant submits a pre-motion letter, the April 22, 2011 conference shall function as a pre-motion conference.
