**STIPULATION REGARDING ORDER OF
FORFEITURE ENTERED ON MARCH 8, 2012**

The Commonwealth of Kentucky *ex rel.* J. Michael Brown, Secretary of the Justice and Public Safety Cabinet, by counsel, stipulates as follows:

1. The Commonwealth stipulates that it shall not argue, in relation to or opposition to the domain name defendants (or any individual or entity claiming to be an owner or lien holder thereof) identified in footnote 1 of the Commonwealth's Motion for Entry of Order of Forfeiture of Domain Defendants ("Excluded Domains"),¹ that the Order of Forfeiture of Domain Defendants entered by the Franklin Circuit Court, Division II, on March 8, 2012, has any factual or legal relevance or precedential value with respect to the Excluded Domains or in any way precludes any legal or factual argument those defendants may make, either procedurally or substantively, in this action, any appeal, or any other action.


2. The Commonwealth further stipulates that the Order of Forfeiture applies only to the domain names listed on Exhibit A attached to the Order of Forfeiture of Domain Defendants entered by the Franklin Circuit Court, Division II, on March 8, 2012.

3. Nothing in this stipulation shall be construed to prevent or limit the Commonwealth from seeking in relation to the Excluded Domains an order similar or identical to the March 8, 2012, Order (a "Future Order").

4. Nothing in this Stipulation shall be construed to prevent or limit the Commonwealth from arguing the preclusive effect of any Future Order.
