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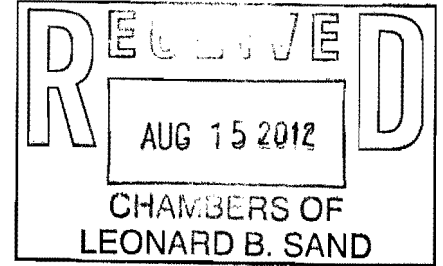

This letter is to request the Court's approval for Claimant Robb Evans of Robb Evans & Associates LLC, in his capacity as Receiver ("Receiver") appointed pursuant to the Preliminary Injunction Order ("Preliminary Injunction") issued in the case of *Federal Trade Commission v. Jeremy Johnson, etc., et al.*, United States District Court, District of Nevada, Case No. 2:10-cv-02203-RLH-GWF ("FTC Action"), to file a short Surreply to the Reply Memorandum of Law in Further Support of the Government's Motion to Strike the Claim of Robb Evans of Robb Evans & Associates LLC, Receiver (Doc. No. 249) (the "Government's Reply") not to exceed five pages in length and to be filed by not later than August 21, 2012. The Government's Reply seeks to strike the Receiver's Verified Claim with prejudice and without leave to amend based on certain misstatements of fact regarding the scope of the receivership estate and ambiguities regarding the basis of the Receiver's claim which the Receiver seeks to correct in his Surreply.

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The Receiver has conferred with counsel for plaintiff Government, Jason H. Cowley, who has consented to the Receiver's filing a Surreply under the terms requested herein.
