

Plaintiff's failure to file written objections precludes appellate review of this decision. See Caidor v. Onondaga Cty., 517 F.3d 601, 604 (2d Cir. 2008).

Accordingly, the Court adopts the Report in full, dismissing the petition with prejudice. The Clerk of the Court is directed to close the case.
