Be well read with iBooks and all its latest features. Download the iBooks app from the App Store. Then fill your iPhone, iPod touch, or iPad library with books from the iBookstore. The iBookstore is just the beginning.

Start with the bookshelf. With a tap, it flips around to reveal the iBookstore, where you'll find over 1.5 million books and counting* — many of them free. View what's featured on the iBookstore and the New York Times best-seller lists, or browse by title, author, or genre. Find a book you like and tap to see more details, peruse reviews, even read a free sample. Purchase a book and it downloads to your bookshelf, ready to read.

Works with iCloud

More ways with words.



Reading on iPhone, iPod touch, or iPad is just like reading a book. But once you get started, you'll see it's so much more. Go from prologue to epilogue by turning pages with a flick, or read in one continuous vertical scroll. Read one page at a time, or turn your device on its side and view two pages at once. Tap to read everything full screen, with no distractions, or read in white-on-black nighttime mode. Even alter the look of most books by changing their text size and font.



iBooks and iCloud.

iCloud stores the stuff you care about — your music, photos, and contacts, for example — and makes it accessible from your iPhone, iPad, iPod touch, or Mac. iCloud even stores your books. And it doesn't matter which device you use to buy them, because you'll see every title you've purchased on your bookshelf. If you want it on your device, just tap to download it. So you can read one of your favorites on your iPhone during your morning commute and pick up right where you left off on your iPad at bedtime.

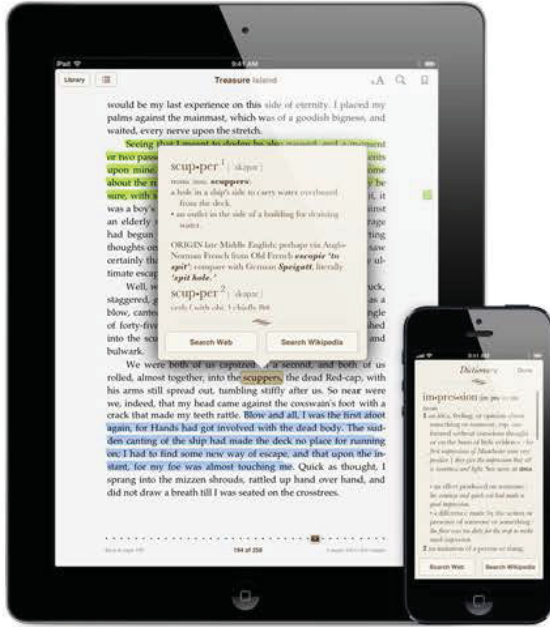

Multi-Touch textbooks for iPad.

With iBooks textbooks, you can flip through a book by sliding a finger along thumbnail images of the pages. You're no longer limited to the flat images on paper: Flick through a photo gallery. Use a finger to rotate a 3D object. Watch animations spring to life or listen to a lesson instead of reading it. It's like nothing you've ever experienced. 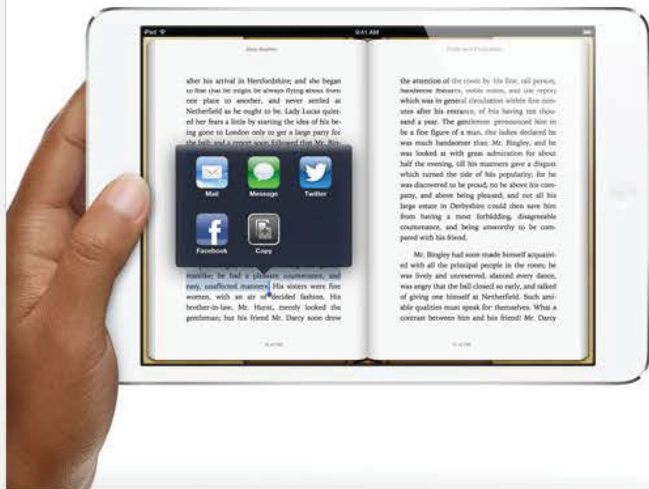


All the highlights. And the notes. And the definitions.

Use your finger as a highlighter when you're reading a book on your iOS device. Just swipe over the selected text, and it's highlighted. Tap a highlighted section and a palette appears. Change colors, switch to underline, or add a note instantly. Then switch to the Notes view to see all your notes and highlights instantly organized in one place, making it a cinch to search or go back to the highlighted sections of your book.

NEW Out with the old edition. In with the new edition.

Books — especially textbooks — get updated for any number of reasons. Thankfully, the iBooks app supports book updates. That means if a book you purchased is republished with new or additional content, iBooks lets you know. You can download the updated version free, and it automatically replaces the older copy on your bookshelf.



NEW Share quotes on Facebook or Twitter.

Maybe you're reading a hilarious take on family that's spot on about yours. Or you come across a fact that supports the premise of your thesis. All you know is, you have to share it. With iBooks, you can share the perfect phrase directly from the page on Facebook or Twitter. You can also send a snippet via text or email.

Put PDFs on your bookshelf.

In addition to keeping all your books in one place, iBooks stores your PDF files. User guides, business proposals, project plans — all go on your bookshelf, too. When someone emails you a PDF, open it in iBooks. Or sync the PDFs on your Mac or PC to your iOS device. Then go to your bookshelf and tap to open one.
