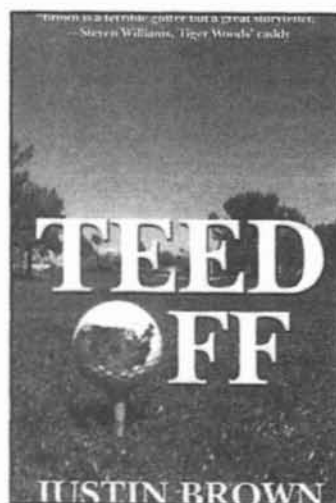

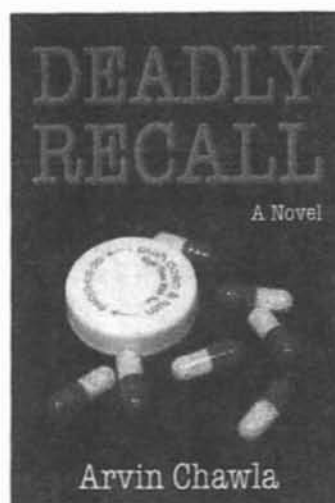
Teed Off in the USA

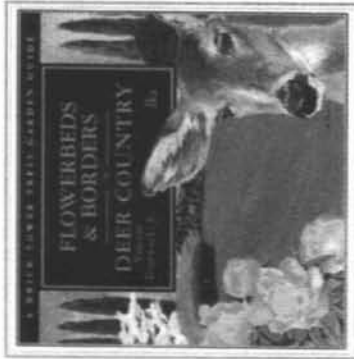

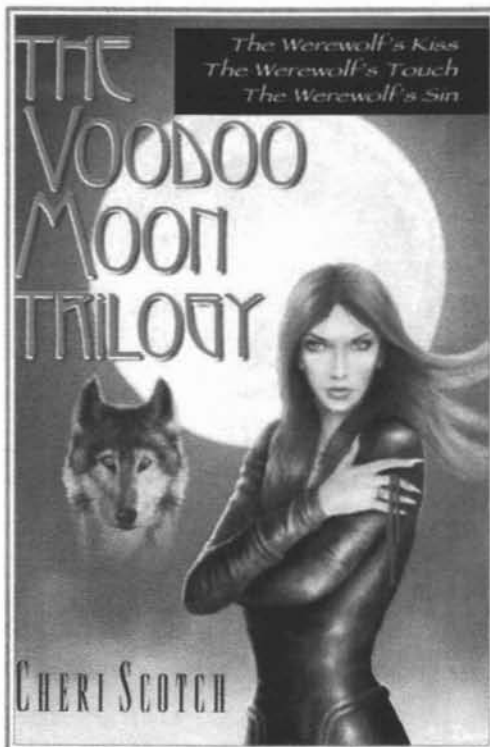
