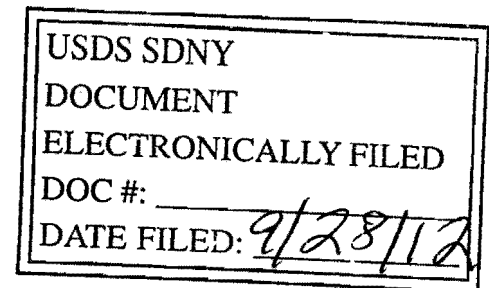

I filed a Motion for Admission Pro Hac Vice on August 3, 2012 in *The Authors Guild, Inc. v. HathiTrust*, No. 1:11-cv-06351-IIB. (See Docket Entry No. 151.)
