RICHARD J. SULLIVAN, District Judge:

The Court is in receipt of two pre-motion letters, from Adelman Matz P.C., counsel for Defendant ReDigi Inc., and Mishcon de Reya New York LLP, counsel for Defendants ReDigi Inc., John Ossenmacher, and Larry Rudolph, each asking for leave to file a motion to withdraw as counsel under seal for *in camera* review. (Doc. Nos. 230, 231.) The Court grants counsels' requests and allows the motions to be filed under seal for *in camera* review. *See Thekkek v. LaserSculpt, Inc.*, No. 11-cv-4426 (HB) (JLC), 2012 WL 225924, at *3 (S.D.N.Y. Jan. 23, 2012). Once the Court has reviewed the submissions, it will determine whether the presumption of open records has been overcome and the submissions may remain under seal. *Lugosch v. Pyramid Co. of Onondaga*, 435 F.3d 110, 119–20 (2d Cir. 2006). Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Adelman Matz P.C. and Mishcon de Reya New York LLP shall submit their motions to withdraw under seal by June 27, 2016.
