RICHARD J. SULLIVAN, District Judge:

The Court is in receipt of a submission from counsel for Defendant ReDigi, Inc. seeking to substitute Meister Seelig & Fein LLP for Ray Beckerman, P.C. as Defendant's attorneys of record. Local Civil Rule 1.4, which governs the withdrawal or displacement of attorney of record, dictates that "[a]n attorney who has appeared as attorney of record for a party may be relieved or displaced only by order of the Court and may not withdraw from a case without leave of the Court granted by order." The rule further states that "[s]uch an order may be granted only upon a showing by affidavit or otherwise of satisfactory reasons for withdrawal or displacement and the posture of the case, including its position, if any, on the calendar." The Court has not received any such affidavit or "otherwise satisfactory reasons." Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Defendant's request is denied. If Defendant intends to make another such request, it shall follow Local Civil Rule 1.4.
