We represent plaintiff Capitol Records, LLC ("Capitol") in the above-referenced action and write jointly with counsel for the defendant, ReDigi Inc. ("ReDigi"). The parties jointly request a four day adjustment of the current briefing schedule for summary judgment motions in order to accommodate counsel's vacation schedules. The parties propose that summary judgment opposition papers would be due on August 14 instead of August 10, and that reply papers would be due on August 24 instead of August 20. This schedule would still result in briefing being completed six weeks in advance of oral argument, which has been scheduled for October 5, 2010.
