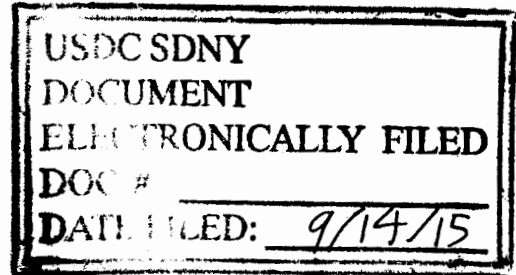

OPINION


