Fed. Exp.*, 766 F.3d 189, 194 (2d Cir. 2014). If, however, Plaintiff does not respond to this Order, either by responding to the motion for summary judgment or by submitting a letter indicating that he does not intend to do so, then the Court may dismiss this action for failure to prosecute pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b).
