ORDER

The Court has received and reviewed Plaintiff’s “Letter to the Senior Judge Hon. Sections 351-364. To the extent Plaintiff requests to stay the Court’s orders or for reconsideration of the same, disqualification, or recusal, those requests are denied for the reasons stated in the Court’s August 13, 2021, Order. (See docket entry no. 175.)
