I am an Assistant Corporation Counsel in the Office of the Hon. Sylvia O. Hinds-Radix, Corporation Counsel of the City of New York, representing Defendant, the City of New York, in the above-referenced matter. In accordance with the Court's Order of October 4, 2022, (ECF No. 68), I submit this joint letter along with Susanne Toes Keane of NYLAG, settlement counsel to the Plaintiff, to advise the Court regarding the status of mediation.
