ORDER

GREGORY H. WOODS, United States District Judge:

On September 30, 2019, Jonathan Perez filed a petition for habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2255. Dkt. No. 670¹; Case No. 1:19-cv-9129, Dkt. No. 1. On January 24, 2025, counsel for Mr. Perez filed a letter requesting that Mr. Perez’s “28 U.S.C. § 2255 Petition and all subsequent memoranda in support of the petition” be withdrawn. Dkt. No. 1059. Mr. Perez’s counsel writes that Mr. Perez “understands that due to this request, his § 2255 Petition will be withdrawn and that it cannot be refiled.” *Id.* Mr. Perez’s application is granted.


Mr. Perez’s petition for habeas corpus relief is withdrawn. All deadlines established by the Court with respect to the litigation of the issues presented in connection with that petition are adjourned *sine die*.
