ORDER OF SERVICE

By Order dated September 24, 2021, the Court granted Plaintiff's request to proceed without prepayment of fees, that is, *in forma pauperis* (ECF No. 5). Plaintiff filed an Amended Complaint on September 13, 2022 (ECF No. 34), which names additional defendants that have not yet been served.
