We are the attorneys for Plaintiff Alec Tabak ("Plaintiff") in this matter. Pursuant to Section I(B)(5) of Your Honor's Individual Rules and Practices, we write to respectfully request an adjournment of the initial conference date until at least 14 days after Defendant Source Digital, Inc. ("Defendant")'s deadline for responding to the Complaint. The adjournment would permit the parties to competently discuss the required topics under Rule 26(f) and the most appropriate case management plan based on Defendant's response to the Complaint.
