ORDER

On July 23, 2024, Petitioners filed a petition to confirm an arbitration award. ECF No. 1. Proceedings to confirm an arbitration award must be “treated as akin to a motion for summary judgment.” *D.H. Blair & Co., Inc. v. Gottdiener*, 462 F.3d 95, 109 (2d Cir. 2006). Accordingly:

1. By **September 2, 2024**, Petitioner shall file and serve a statement pursuant to Local Civil Rule 56.1 and any additional materials with which it intends to support the complaint, including memoranda of law, the arbitration award, supporting documents, and any affidavits or declarations attesting that the exhibits are true and correct copies of what they purport to be;
2. By **September 23, 2024**, Respondents shall file their opposition papers; and
3. By **October 7, 2024**, Petitioner shall file its reply, if any.

By **August 19, 2024**, Petitioner shall serve a copy of the complaint and this order upon Defendants by personal service on an officer, director, managing or general agent, or cashier or assistant cashier or to any other agent authorized by appointment or by law to receive service, pursuant to N.Y. C.P.L.R. § 311. By **August 21, 2024**, Petitioner shall file an affidavit of such service.
