ORDER ADOPTING  
REPORT & RECOMMENDATION


KENNETH M. KARAS, District Judge:

On November 14, 2016, Magistrate Judge Judith C. McCarthy issued a thorough Report & Recommendation (“R&R”) recommending that this Court grant Defendant’s Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings and deny Plaintiff’s Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings. (Dkt. No. 24.) In the R&R, Judge McCarthy provides notice that objections to the R&R were due within 14 days, and that failure to object would preclude later appellate review of any order of judgment that will be entered. (*Id.* at 48–49.) No objections have been filed.

Because no objections have been filed, the Court reviews the R&R only for “clear error on the face of the record.” *Kessler v. Colvin*, 48 F. Supp. 3d 578, 582 (S.D.N.Y. 2014) (internal quotation marks omitted). Having reviewed the R&R for clear error and found none, the Court adopts the R&R in its entirety.

ORDERED that Defendant’s Motion is granted and Plaintiff’s Motion is denied. The Clerk of Court is respectfully requested to terminate this case.
