**ORDER DIRECTING NON-PARTIES
JERUSALEM SHROUDS LLC AND
THE PILLARSTONE GROUP, INC.
TO COMPLY WITH SUBPOENAS**

Upon the application of plaintiff Elavon, Inc. ("Elavon") for an Order (the "Application") directing non-party Jerusalem Shrouds LLC ("Jerusalem Shrouds) and non-party The Pillarstone Group, Inc. ("Pillarstone") to comply with duly-served Subpoenas to Testify At a Deposition In a Civil Action (the "Subpoenas"), and upon review of the submissions of counsel in support thereof, and good cause otherwise appearing, it is hereby


ORDERED that Elavon's Application is **GRANTED**; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that, within 14 days of service of this Order together with a copy of the Subpoena served upon Jerusalem Shrouds earlier, Jerusalem Shrouds shall contact, or shall direct its counsel to confer with, Elavon's counsel concerning its compliance with the Subpoena; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that, within 14 days of service of this Order together with a copy of the Subpoena served upon Pillarstone earlier, Pillarstone shall contact, or shall direct its counsel to confer with, Elavon's counsel concerning its compliance with the Subpoena; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that service of this Order shall be made by personal service upon any principal, agent (other than the New York Secretary of State) or owner of Jerusalem Shrouds and Pillarstone.
