Plaintiffs' memorandum of law in support of the motion was filed under seal pursuant to the amended stipulated protective order filed in this action, ECF No. 284, and a public version of the memorandum of law was filed on the docket, ECF No. 283, with the limited confidential information redacted. The public version and the sealed version of the memorandum of law, however, are not the same versions. Indeed, the cover page of the sealed version contains the title "*Revised* Memorandum of Law in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Class Certification," (emphasis added), whereas the cover page of the public version contains the title "Memorandum of Law in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Class Certification."
