This firm represents Defendants Fross Zelnick Lehrman & Zissu, P.C., Leo Kittay, James D. Weinberger and Terry Raphael (collectively, "Defendants") in connection with the above-referenced matter. This letter is written jointly with Plaintiff's counsel.

Pursuant to Your Honor's Order dated November 1, 2021, the parties were directed to file the settlement documents resolving Plaintiff's claims under the Fair Labor Standard Act and New York Labor Law, including a *Cheeks* fairness letter, by November 19, 2021. The parties have been working diligently to negotiate and draft the settlement documents.
