As set forth in the Court's prior orders, it is Plaintiff's responsibility to notify the Court in writing if his address changes, and the Court may dismiss the action if Plaintiff fails to do so. Accordingly, Plaintiff is directed to notify the Court in writing of his current address by October 1, 2024. Plaintiff is reminded that the Court may dismiss this action if he fails to so notify the Court in writing of a change in address, and that failure to respond to this Court's order will result in dismissal of his case. To the extent known, Defendants are directed to submit a letter notifying the Court of Plaintiff's current address by October 1, 2024.

The Clerk of Court is respectfully directed to mail a copy of this Order to Plaintiff at the address on the docket.
