


4. Mr. Boland asked me repeatedly to sign the declaration and he told me if I emailed the signed declaration to him and Mr. Southwell at the same time, it would be a "convenient way to start a dialogue" between him and Mr. Southwell about the declaration, and that I would not have to be "in the middle" anymore.

5. During the course of our conversations regarding my role as a videographer in this case, I told Mr. Boland that the documents did not change color from the first time I saw them on the morning of July 14, 2011 to the last time I saw them on August 27, 2011 on the video.

6. I did not feel any pressure from Mr. Southwell, Mr. Flynn or anyone else to sign my Superseding Declaration.
